PARTY WALL AGREEMENTS: If a neighbour is proposing to build an extension next to your home, it is advisable to arrange for a Party Wall Agreement to be put in place. The person who is carrying out the works is required by law to pay for this.

<u>BUILDINGS IN BACK GARDENS:</u> If you are concerned, please let us know the address of the building in question.

BONFIRES: Barn Hill is a smoke-free zone, so please refrain from lighting bonfires.

Whatever day a Wembley Stadium Event takes place, if you park in <u>Preston Rd Car Park</u> you are required to pay a fee between 8.00am & midnight, (maximum stay 5 hours, unless pre-booked). Please note that if an Event Day takes place on a <u>Sunday</u> the parking meters are operative within the Event Day Area.

NOISE AND NUISANCE: If you are troubled by builders working out-of-hours, then contact Brent Council's Noise and Nuisance Department on 020 8937 1234. The permitted working hours for builders are as follows:

- 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday
- 8am to 1pm Saturday
 No works are allowed on Sundays or on Bank Holidays.

The same department can be contacted for any other anti-social behaviour.
