<u>BURGLARIES:</u> We are sorry to report that burglaries are still on the increase on the Barn Hill Estate and they are increasingly happening during daylight hours. It has been reported to us that burglars have been targeting houses in the Preston Road area with Mercedes parked outside, with a view to stealing the keys and making off with the cars.

SCAM: Local residents have reported more of the same scam, whereby a criminal purporting to be a Police Officer telephones the householder and claims that their credit card is being used fraudulently. He says he will send a courier to pick up the credit card in question, supposedly to be used in connection with the court case. He invites the victim to ring him back to verify his identity. However, do not <u>under any circumstances</u> use the same telephone to call back, as the criminal will remain on the line to receive your call. Instead ring 999, on **a different phone**, and report the matter to the real Police.
